

Fish kill reported on December 7th!!

Another fish kill has been reported, this time on the Shenandoah River. About 50 Northern Hogsuckers were found on the Main Stem of the Shenandoah between Route 50 and Loches.

Cacapon Institute counted and GPS'ed over 50 in a couple hundred yards of river, and collected about a dozen [for study].

Please consider checking other respective rivers to see if, like this summer, the kill has spread around not only the Shenandoah but also the South Branch and Main Stem of the Potomac. The fish appear to have been dead at least several days so you don't want to wait too long or the evidence will likely be gone. We would value any reports."
